- Must be approved by full voting membership
- Members must affirm their support to MNYF's mission and goals
- Members must be an organization registered with the State of Michigan as a governmental, non-profit, or private proprietary entities which meet the following criteria:
 - Non-profit organizations must have a separate and distinct Board of Directors
 - Organizations must operate at least one separate and distinct program for youth and/or families for the purpose of improving the lives of youth, their families, and their communities
 - Organizations must have a mission which demonstrates support of the purposes of the Network
 - Organizations must pay annual Membership fee based off income of youth programs
 - Organizations must complete an application demonstrating compliance with the above criteria for Membership
